ITEM #3 <u>DISCUSS THE DISTRICT'S NEW WATER & WASTEWATER RATE SCHEDULE FOR</u> RESOLUTION NO. 112-10-14

The **BOARD** discussed the District's proposed new water & wastewater rate schedule for Resolution No. 112-10-14. The **CHAIRMAN** stated the actual increase is not 40% percent of the total bill; it's an increase of 40% only on the minimum. A 1" meter will increase a total of \$12.83 per month, still keeping a 6,000 gallons per month minimum; a 2" meter will increase a total of \$74.15 per month, still keeping a 26,000 gallon per month minimum; a 4" meter will increase a total of \$216.91 per month keeping 101,000 gallons minimum; a 6" meter will increase a total of \$384.00 per month keeping a 101,000 gallons minimum; the 8" and 10" meters will increase \$496.00 per month keeping a 101,000 gallons minimum. The standard residential 5/8" meters will not increase.

Pamela Cody with the Port Isabel-South Padre Press addressed the Board regarding the District's rate increase.

The District plans to give notice of the new water and wastewater rates increase effective January 1, 2015 by individually mailing all LMWD's customers.
